

### <u>UPDATED</u> SRPN Trustee Vacancy Positions for Nomination

In this issue, you will find a **SAMPLE** of the required form for the Trustee self-nomination. We are required by law to formally notify every homeowner individually by mail of the call for nominations. **This official communication** will be mailed to the homeowner of record on **September 10, 2024**. You will have two weeks from that date in which to self-nominate. We are giving advance notification of the mailing in this issue of our Newsletter so that you have time to consider running for Trustee.

One (1) Vacant Trustee position will end on December 31, 2025. That new term will run for one (1) year which will begin on January 1, 2025 and will expire on December 31, 2025. The Trustee positions currently being held by Mark Cosenzo, Michael Delpome, Christina Tassone, and a Vacant Trustee position will end on December 31, 2024. These new terms will run for two (2) years which will begin on January 1, 2025 and will expire on December 31, 2026.

It must be noted that Nominees will be competing for all five (5) Trustee positions, and not for any one (1) position listed. The Radburn Law states that the five (5) Trustee positions be awarded to the top five (5) candidates with the most votes.

Hello again everyone.

The board has completed its revisions and approval of the Reserve Study and the Governing Documents. All documents have been sent back to the engineers for their review. I'll keep you posted on the progress of both of these issues.

### Townhall Meeting at our October HOA Meeting

Mayor Bacchione spoke at the September Coalition Meeting, regarding how the Berkeley Township's insurance premiums have risen dramatically this year. Part of the cause of this is due to injuries to the township employees – specifically the employees who man our garbage trucks.

All of Berkeley Township has Robo-Garbage Pick-Up, with the exception of the adult communities. The trucks will pick up a robo-garbage can which the township provides to the residents free of charge, for the first one. These cans are on wheels and are not heavy at all. The cans are available in two sizes: a large 96 gallon size and a small 64 gallon size.

Robo-Garbage Pick-up applies to regular trash pick-up and recycling pick-up. (Recycling cans are blue.) NO EMPLOYEES WILL LOSE THEIR JOBS DUE TO THIS. Mayor Bacchione agreed to bring samples of these cans to our October Townhall Meeting, which will be held during our October Homeowners Meeting.

Robo-Garbage Pick-Up was proposed once before that the adult communities use the robo-trash cans, but this was rejected due to the fact that residents were concerned they would not be able to maneuver the cans to the street and back to their homes. The township has come up with, what I think, is a workable solution to this concern:

- Before the garbage truck arrives at the home, a crew will go ahead of the garbage truck to move the robo-can from your house to the street.
- After the trash is collected, the crew will then move the robo-can back up to your house.

The township will put in place a system so this courtesy can't be abused. For instance, I am able to put a robo-can out to the street and back to my home without having a township employee do it for me, and therefore, shouldn't have this service. I think many of our residents are fortunate to be in this category.

However, if you are not able to do this and would like to have this service, you will need to have your doctor give you a prescription stating that you are unable to move these cans to the street and back to your home. There will also be a form you will need to fill out for the town. The township does not want to know your medical history – they only need your doctor's prescription stating you cannot perform this task and to complete a simple form. This should prevent the service from being abused by folks that don't really need it.

I had Robo-Garbage Pick-Up where I lived before moving to SRPN and was disappointed when it wasn't available here.

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





### Just a Note - Worth Repeating

October is Breast Cancer Awareness Month

I was reminded, while chatting with a group at the pool this summer, that some women think if you're over 65 years of age, you don't need an annual mammogram. With this in mind, I'm sharing my story once again, hoping it makes a difference in someone's life.

Like most of you, admittedly, I never paid much attention to the Public Awareness advertisement for "One in Eight Women will develop breast cancer". (I'm sure you've seen it ... it's the one that has 7 white, and 1 pink paper doll cut-outs.) Why would I? I had no family history of breast cancer, and I always went faithfully for my annual mammogram. But in 2019, I became painfully aware of every single magazine advertisement, television commercial and billboard for breast cancer awareness.

It was March when I received the telephone call (one month after my annual mammogram) telling me that it was 'me' who was the one in eight. I immediately thought, "Nah, they must have made a mistake!" After all, I was in my late 60's, I didn't have ANY symptoms, no lump, no family history, and I felt great! But after I viewed the films, I saw for myself, there was no mistake ... indeed, I had breast cancer.

Due to early detection, fortunately, the cancer was still in its early stages, so I had options. I was told I could wait and see if it becomes more invasive and then act on it, or I could deal with it now. Well, I've never been a 'wait and see' person, so I proceeded to set up consultation appointments with two different local breast cancer specialists the very next day. The two doctors each had a plan of action that were at total opposite ends of the spectrum, leaving me frustrated and very confused.

Then a recommendation from my niece's mother-in-law led me to a third doctor. During that consultation, the doctor explained in detail the type of breast cancer I had developed. After we talked about my lifestyle and my expectations, she then recommended a procedure that we both agreed would have the best results for me. ALL my questions and concerns were answered, and my mind was put at ease. After three separate and very different consultations, I finally found my specialist. AND I am happy to report that I am now 5+ years cancer free.

I've said it before, but this is worth repeating - I am very grateful to all the women who shared their personal cancer stories with me when I was first diagnosed - it made my journey a lot less lonely. "Thank you all so much!"

- Researchers say the incidence of breast cancer increases with age, and almost half of all new breast cancers in the U.S. are diagnosed in women aged 65 or over.
- Have a monthly self-breast exam and inform your doctor of any concerns.
- Do not put off having your Annual Mammogram Early Detection Saves Lives! Also - if you have 'dense breast tissue' talk to your doctor to see if getting an Ultrasound, along with Mammogram, is right for you. A routine dense breast tissue ultrasound was key in detecting early stage of breast cancer for me.
- If it's not an emergency situation, always get a second (or THIRD) opinion!
- Men, not just women, develop breast cancer, so report concerns to your doctor.

### Township of Berkely Municipal Codes for Animal Control / DOGS



#### 9-2.2. Leash Required {1974 Code 75-13}

No person owning, keeping or harboring any dog shall suffer or permit it to be upon the public streets or in any of the public places of the Township unless such dog is accompanied by a person over the age of 12 years or by a person who is capable of controlling it and is securely confined and controlled by an adequate leash not more than six feet long.

#### 9-2.4. Dogs on Private Property {1974 Code 75-15}

No owner of any dog shall suffer or permit such dog to be upon any private property other than the premises of the owner without the consent of the owner or tenant of the private property.

### 9-2.5. Nuisances {1974 Code 75-16; Ord. No. 84-1}

No person owning or having the care, custody or control of any dog shall permit such dog to soil, defile, defecate on or commit any nuisance upon any sidewalk, street or thoroughfare in or upon any public property or in or upon the property of persons other than the owner or person having the care, custody or control of such dog.

### 9-2.8. Responsibility of Owner {1974 Code 75-19; Ord. No. 84-1}

The owner or custodian of any dog shall be responsible for the damages done by his dog. The quarters where dogs are kept shall be clean and sanitary at all times and such as not to create a health hazard. In addition, the owner of, or any person having custody, care or control of, any dog which shall soil or defecate on any property contrary to the provisions of Subsection 9-2.5 shall forthwith remove such soil or defecation from such property and deposit the same in a garbage can or receptacle.

#### 9-14.3. Requirement for Disposal (Ord. No 05-25-OAB 3)

All pet owners and keepers are required to immediately and properly dispose of their pet's solid waste deposited on any property, public or private, not owned or possessed by that person. **PROPER DISPOSAL-** Shall mean placement in a designated waste receptacle, or other suitable container, and discarded in a refuse container which is regularly emptied by the municipality or some other refuse collector; or disposal into a system designed to convey domestic sewage for proper treatment and disposal.

#### 9-2.13. Disturbing the Peace; Failure to Provide Control (1974 Code 75-22; Ord. No. 94-28)

- a. No person shall keep, within any residential zone of the Township, any dog causing a nuisance and disturbing the peace and quiet of the neighborhood in which it shall be kept, by excessive, loud and continuous howling or barking or making and causing other such sounds or noises.
- b. No owner shall fail to exercise proper control of his dog to prevent it from becoming a public nuisance. Excessive, continuous or untimely barking, molesting passersby, chasing vehicles, habitually attacking other domestic animals, trespassing upon school grounds or trespassing upon private or public property shall be deemed a nuisance.

#### 9-2.14. Violations and Penalties {1974 Code 75-23; Ord. No. 84-1; Ord. No. 94-28}

Any person, whether as owner or custodian of a dog, convicted of a violation of any of the provisions of the section shall, upon conviction of any of the provisions thereof, be subject to a fine or penalty not exceeding \$500 or imprisonment for a term not exceeding 90 days, or both, at the discretion of the Judge before whom such conviction is had. In addition to or in lieu of impounding a dog found at large, the Animal Control Officer may issue to the known owner of such dog a summons for violations of this section.

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### OCEAN RIDE ~ Reserve-A-Ride Program

Ocean County Transportation Services Department

Seniors (age 60 and over) and/or persons with disabilities (age 18 and over) on an advanced reservation basis primarily to destinations within Ocean County. Pre-registration is NOT required, just call us when you need your appointment.

You may call Ocean Ride Monday through Friday only, from 8:00 AM to 4:30 PM to make your trip reservation. We accept trip reservations on a first-come, first serve basis, up to (4) four weeks in advance. All trip requests are to be handled by telephone by calling (732) 736-8989, then press "1" to speak with a Reservationist.

The Reserve-A-Ride program is primarily designed to serve routine medical needs of Ocean County residents. Unlike the Fixed Bus Routes, this service does not operate on the basis of a printed schedule, rather routes and pick-up times are developed each day in response to the service requests we receive. All vehicles are wheelchair lift equipped.

Once your reservation has been made, the driver will arrive anytime within 1 hour to 1½ hours of the scheduled appointment time (depending on your travel distance). In accordance with Ocean Ride's Safety Policy, our **Drivers are NOT permitted to enter your home**, thus we require that you be at ground level for your scheduled pick up.

> Riders will be billed via mail, the month AFTER service. Absolutely NO CASH HANDLING on-board the Reserve-A-Ride vehicles.

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### Silver Ridge Park North Shed Rules

After discussion regarding sheds at the Silver Ridge Park North (SRPN) Trustee meeting, held on Tuesday, April 7, 2015, the Trustees unanimously agreed to Rules 1-8. Updated Permit/Form information - February 2019.

- 1. In keeping with Berkeley Township's Shed Ordinance, homeowners are permitted, effective this date, to install one (1) shed on their property; up to and including 120 square feet (10 ft. x 12 ft.);
- 2. Said shed may be of any structure material the homeowner desires;
- 3. Sheds that are required to be fastened must be on a firm ground structure. DO NOT place any shed on a cement slab. Cement slabs add square feet to your taxable living space and will be taxable by Berkeley Township;

- 4. Sheds may NOT be installed on any Common Ground Property;
- 5. In accordance with Berkeley Township Ordinance, sheds must be placed at least three (3) feet from the back property line and at least (3) feet from the side property line;
- 6. If a homeowner chooses to install a shed adjacent to their home, it may NOT block any windows or doors;
- 7. Homeowners MUST submit an Architectural Approval Request form to the SRPN Architectural Committee. *Architectural Approval Request forms are available in the SRPN Clubhouse Lobby;*
- 8. The homeowner MUST submit a **Zoning Permit Application**, required fees, and forms to the Berkeley Township Town Hall/Zoning Office. *Zoning Permit Application forms can be obtained from the Berkeley Township Website or Zoning Office*.

## IMPORTANT INFORMATION S R P NORTH HOMEOWNERS

#### ARCHITECTURAL COMMITTEE

Prior to obtaining a permit from the Berkeley Township Construction Office and/or Zoning Office, homeowners must obtain a "Architectural Approval Request " form from the Architectural Committee. Sheds, upgrades, renovations, repairs, additions, exterior changes, anything pertain to the grounds, trees, driveway construction and sidewalks all require approval from the Architectural Committee. Note: Homeowners may need to submit a Zoning Permit Application, required fees, and forms to the Berkeley Township Town Hall/Zoning Office. Contact the Zoning Office for instructions.

#### COMMON GROUNDS

No debris, grass cuttings, landscape material, leaves, old plants, tree branches should be dumped in the common grounds. Violators are subject to Berkeley Township fines.

## SELLING/RENTING OF HOMES

When selling your home, either on your own or through a Real Estate Agent, you must notify the HOA <u>BEFORE</u> your buyer completes the 'New Purchaser's Packet' and provide the HOA with two (2) forms of identification; one being a photo ID showing birthdates for <u>each occupant</u> of the home. (See pg.2 for appt. information) SRPN By-Laws require one (1) year homeowner's ownership prior to renting their property.

Landlords AND Tenants must complete the HOA's 'Lease Agreement Packet' and provide the HOA with two (2) forms of identification; one being a photo I.D. showing birthdates for each occupant <u>and</u> a copy of the Lease.

All buyers and tenants (all residents) must appear <u>in</u> <u>person</u> at the HOA office with the required identification and paperwork. Berkeley Township will not issue a C.O. (Certificate of Occupancy) without the HOA's Letter stating the buyer/tenants are in good standing with the Homeowners Association.

#### SIDEWALKS

It is each homeowner's responsibility to repair and maintain sidewalks on their property. All lifted and cracked sidewalks require repair at the homeowner's expense.

#### TREES

It is the homeowner's responsibility to prune and maintain trees located on their property. Also, no tree in the common ground, or wildlife corridor, may be pruned, removed, or topped for any purpose, including installation of solar panels. Trees in these areas needing attention should be brought to the attention of the Common Ground Trees Committee.

#### OTHER IMPORTANT REMINDERS

- Parking/storage of inoperable, unregistered, or uninsured motor vehicles, boats, or any other watercrafts, trailers, and/or recreational vehicles are not allowed anywhere on your property or Common Grounds.
- Berkeley Township Ordinance: Trash/garbage
  is to be put out at the curb <u>AFTER 4:00pm</u> on
  the day before a scheduled pickup. RECYCLED
  ITEMS are to be placed curbside, in reusable
  containers or <u>paper</u> bags, <u>AFTER 5:00pm</u> on
  the day before a scheduled pick up.
- All pets are required to be leashed. You must pick up and remove your pet's waste, even if you walk them in the common ground area.
- It is the Homeowner's responsibility to maintain their grass and/or stone lawns.
- A Berkeley Township Ordinance strictly prohibits the feeding of wild animals consisting of, but not limiting to, the following: DEER, rabbits, squirrels, chipmunks, and groundhogs. Wild birds are excluded.
