

I hope this letter finds you well; my name is **Ed DeMeo**, but I am better known as the guy who walks Rigatoni around town.

I have seen a great deal of growth in this community since we joined its ranks four years ago. The capital projects-the rehabilitation of the community pool to the refurbishment of the club house with the addition of a new roof and a new parking lot - tell only on part of the community's success story. Neighbors have come together to enjoy the pool-side Grill and Chill, attended special events at the clubhouse and participated in the Men's Club River Cruise. I have come to greatly appreciate the community interaction, making new friends and supporting the community; I presently serve as the Vice President of the Men's Club.

I ask that you consider me for a trustee position, so I may help build upon the good work already accomplished.

The concept of community has been of great importance to me as a life-long educator, especially as I transitioned from high school English Teacher to Assistant Principal to Principal in the New York City system. Everything accomplished in education is based on enhancing the communal life for all constituents. I bring 28 years of managing people and resources as an educator, and three years of business experience. Combined, I have been coordinating with people to achieve common goals for 31 years. As a result, I have learned to become an active listener who will thoroughly listen to others and then share an opinion. I believe in working for the common good. Thank you.

#### **<u>Vito Tassone</u>** - 16 Mapleton Rd - Summary of Work Experience

I was a Trustee for 4 years (2015-2018) and volunteered as the HOA's bookkeeper for two more years (2019-2020). During my four years as Trustee, my accomplishments included realigning the Terms of Trustees as they are today, revising the Financial Report in our HOA Newsletter, creating a comprehensive budget and creating an Emergency Fund in the Capital Budget. I also was the lead Trustee in formulating a plan to renovate, repair and upgrade our Clubhouse and pool. The work was prioritized and scheduled in phases over a 3 year period. This included, but not limited to, renovating bathrooms, card room, billiard room and Hallway. The banquet hall was renovated by installing a new floor, ceiling panels, ceiling fans and LED lights. A new heating system and A/C Units were installed and the pool was completely overhauled. We also installed a new Handicap Ramp, new sidewalks and modified the entrance/parking lot curbs to be graded without a curb.

I was very lucky to have worked with a number of Trustees during those years that put aside their differences and worked as a team to get all that work done. Everything we did was with the Community in mind and we never forgot that when making decisions.

I am running for Trustee so that I can continue serving our Community and help keep our HOA on the right course through my experience and knowledge. I had been a big asset during my years serving our HOA and am ready to take it to the next level. I am open minded and willing to work together to get things done. Thank you Vito Tassone

#### **SRPN Presidents Report**

Hello everyone. Hard to believe November is here and we will begin celebrating the holidays again.

At our October HOA meeting, Mayor Bacchione held his annual "Townhall" meeting which was very informative and well attended. I can't review all the topics, but I'll give you some of the highlights.

- Tunnel to Towers will be building Veteran Housing in Berkeley Township at Route 9 and Sloop Creek Rd., covering eight acres. Housing will consist of 99 apartments, 24 single family homes, along with having medical and exercise facilities on site. These homes and apartments will be Deed Restricted, meaning only veterans will be eligible to live there.
- Robo cans are coming to the adult communities in Berkeley Township beginning in 2025. Each household will get two (2) FREE 65-gallon robo-cans; one for garbage, one for recycling. A 95-gallon can is available, instead of a 65-gallon, BUT you must sign up with DPW. They are creating a list, so if you're interested give them a call and get on their list. If you need more than one can, you will pay for the extra one, and this money will be refunded to you upon return of the can. Having robo-cans will allow the Township to have half the number of trucks on the road which translates into half the fuel used. This is a huge savings. Weekly pick up schedule will remain the same. Bulk pickup being done the day after our regular garbage day, and you will need to contact DPW ahead of time to make them aware you have a bulk pickup.
- Code Enforcement was also at the meeting. As a resident, you can call Code Enforcement if you see an issue in our neighborhood that concerns you, which is kept confidential. For example, someone not maintaining their home is something we deal with often. There is the benefit of 'time' if you call the township instead of going through the HOA. When a complaint is filed with us, it takes a minimum of thirty days. We've had complaints that have taken five months to resolve due to the steps the HOA is required to take. The township can resolve this complaint much faster than we can.





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
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#### **SRPN Men's Club Report**

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#### OCEAN RIDE ~ Reserve-A-Ride Program

Ocean County Transportation Services Department

Seniors (age 60 and over) and/or persons with disabilities (age 18 and over) on an advanced reservation basis primarily to destinations within Ocean County. **Pre-registration is NOT required, just call us when you need your appointment.** 

You may call Ocean Ride Monday through Friday only, from 8:00 AM to 4:30 PM to make your trip reservation. We accept trip reservations on a first-come, first serve basis, up to (4) four weeks in advance. All trip requests are to be handled by telephone by calling (732) 736-8989, then press "1" to speak with a Reservationist.

The Reserve-A-Ride program is primarily designed to serve routine medical needs of Ocean County residents. Unlike the Fixed Bus Routes, this service does not operate on the basis of a printed schedule, rather routes and pick-up times are developed each day in response to the service requests we receive. All vehicles are wheelchair lift equipped.

Once your reservation has been made, the driver will arrive anytime within 1 hour to 1½ hours of the scheduled appointment time (depending on your travel distance). In accordance with Ocean Ride's Safety Policy, our Drivers are NOT permitted to enter your home, thus we require that you be at ground level for your scheduled pick up.

Riders will be billed via mail, the month AFTER service.

Absolutely NO CASH HANDLING on-board the Reserve-A-Ride vehicles.

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#### Silver Ridge Park North Shed Rules

After discussion regarding sheds at the Silver Ridge Park North (SRPN) Trustee meeting, held on Tuesday, April 7, 2015, the Trustees unanimously agreed to Rules 1-8. Updated Permit/Form information - February 2019.

- 1. In keeping with Berkeley Township's Shed Ordinance, homeowners are permitted, effective this date, to install one (1) shed on their property; up to and including 120 square feet (10 ft. x 12 ft.);
- 2. Said shed may be of any structure material the homeowner desires;
- 3. Sheds that are required to be fastened must be on a firm ground structure. DO NOT place any shed on a cement slab. Cement slabs add square feet to your taxable living space and will be taxable by Berkeley Township;

- 4. Sheds may NOT be installed on any Common Ground Property;
- 5. In accordance with Berkeley Township Ordinance, sheds must be placed at least three (3) feet from the back property line and at least (3) feet from the side property line;
- 6. If a homeowner chooses to install a shed adjacent to their home, it may NOT block any windows or doors;
- 7. Homeowners MUST submit an Architectural Approval Request form to the SRPN Architectural Committee. *Architectural Approval Request forms are available in the SRPN Clubhouse Lobby;*
- 8. The homeowner MUST submit a **Zoning Permit Application**, required fees, and forms to the Berkeley Township Town Hall/Zoning Office. *Zoning Permit Application forms can be obtained from the Berkeley Township Website or Zoning Office*.

As technology continues to play a significant role in data retention, acquisition and use, it is extremely important to **guard your personal information**.

Various companies / businesses that you conduct transactions with often ask you for more information than they need to provide service. Most physicians request your social security number when filling out questionnaires - DO NOT give it to them - they do not need it. The same applies to Reward Cards provided by grocery stores, pharmacies etc. If asked for your date of birth on any questionnaire, leave it blank. If asked to provide it, ask why. Obviously, in some cases, it is necessary.

If asked for a photo ID, avoid providing your driver's license if possible, and if you must, demand that they not copy it. State Photo ID cards can be easily obtained and are a much safer method. Passports, Military ID's, VA ID Cards and any government issued photo ID will suffice. A state driver's license has enough data to open a credit card account.

RE: 2024 HOPA Update Required

Dear SRPN Resident(s):

The Federal Housing of Urban Development (HUD) mandates that all residents living/owning in an adult community must update their HOPA form every two years. SRPN residents complete the age-verification forms during the even years (ex.: 2024, 2026, etc.) regardless of date of closing or last submission. Recently a Resolution was filed with Ocean County which states any household that is not compliant will be subject to a \$500 fine. To avoid a fine, it is imperative that you return your 2024 HOPA form to the Association, either by mail, placing it in the drop box on the right side of the front door, or personally bringing it to the office. It is not necessary for you to submit another copy of your identification photos unless there has been an increase in the number of occupants residing with you. If this is the case, they must make an appointment to personally come to the office with two pieces of identification that show their birthdate. Also, a new form is required should the number of occupants decrease. Please be sure you provide the requested information for everyone occupying the property.

Should you have any questions, please feel free to contact the HOA office. The telephone number is listed above. The HOA office is open Monday – Friday between 9:00 - 11:00 am, and Wednesday evening 6:00 to 8:00 pm.

# Federal Housing for Older Persons Act (HOPA) 2024 Verification of Occupancy Survey

The Housing for Older Persons Act was signed into law on December 28,1995 by President Bill Clinton. The HOPA provides housing for older persons and is intended for occupancy by at least one person 55 years of age or older per unit. It requires that every two years information must be collected and verified with the age of ALL occupants. Under NJ Law, a letter regarding age is required to be filed with the deed.

# IMPORTANT INFORMATION S R P NORTH HOMEOWNERS

## **ARCHITECTURAL COMMITTEE**

Prior to obtaining a permit from the Berkeley Township Construction Office and/or Zoning Office, homeowners must obtain a "Architectural Approval Request " form from the Architectural Committee. Sheds, upgrades, renovations, repairs, additions, exterior changes, anything pertain to the grounds, trees, driveway construction and sidewalks all require approval from the Architectural Committee. Note: Homeowners may need to submit a Zoning Permit Application, required fees, and forms to the Berkeley Township Town Hall/Zoning Office. Contact the Zoning Office for instructions.

## COMMON GROUNDS

No debris, grass cuttings, landscape material, leaves, old plants, tree branches should be dumped in the common grounds. Violators are subject to Berkeley Township fines.

## LAWS GOVERNING S R P NORTH

Mandatory Federal, NJ State, Berkeley Township Laws, SRPN Association Covenant-Restrictions and By-Laws and Robert Rules are instruments of the rule of law that the sitting Board of Trustees must follow to meet their obligations.

- State of New Jersey Full Disclosure Act and Regulations Title #5.

# SELLING/RENTING OF HOMES

When selling your home, either on your own or through a Real Estate Agent, you must notify the HOA <u>BEFORE</u> your buyer completes the 'New Purchaser's Packet' and provide the HOA with two (2) forms of identification; one being a photo ID showing birthdates for <u>each occupant</u> of the home. (See pg.2 for appt. information) SRPN By-Laws require one (1) year homeowner's ownership prior to renting their property.

Landlords AND Tenants must complete the HOA's 'Lease Agreement Packet' and provide the HOA with two (2) forms of identification; one being a photo I.D. showing birthdates for each occupant <u>and</u> a copy of the Lease.

All buyers and tenants (all residents) must appear <u>in</u> <u>person</u> at the HOA office with the required identification and paperwork. Berkeley Township will not issue a C.O. (Certificate of Occupancy) without the HOA's Letter stating the buyer/tenants are in good standing with the Homeowners Association.

## SIDEWALKS

It is each homeowner's responsibility to repair and maintain sidewalks on their property. All lifted and cracked sidewalks require repair at the homeowner's expense.

### TREES

It is the homeowner's responsibility to prune and maintain trees located on their property. Also, no tree in the common ground, or wildlife corridor, may be pruned, removed, or topped for any purpose, including installation of solar panels. Trees in these areas needing attention should be brought to the attention of the Common Ground Trees Committee.

### OTHER IMPORTANT REMINDERS

- Parking/storage of inoperable, unregistered, or uninsured motor vehicles, boats, or any other watercrafts, trailers, and/or recreational vehicles are not allowed anywhere on your property or Common Grounds.
- Berkeley Township Ordinance: Trash/garbage
  is to be put out at the curb <u>AFTER 4:00pm</u> on
  the day before a scheduled pickup. RECYCLED
  ITEMS are to be placed curbside, in reusable
  containers or <u>paper</u> bags, <u>AFTER 5:00pm</u> on
  the day before a scheduled pick up.
- All pets are required to be leashed. You must pick up and remove your pet's waste, even if you walk them in the common ground area.
- It is the Homeowner's responsibility to maintain their grass and/or stone lawns.
- A Berkeley Township Ordinance strictly prohibits the feeding of wild animals consisting of, but not limiting to, the following: DEER, rabbits, squirrels, chipmunks, and groundhogs. Wild birds are excluded.

As I entered their home, there was a faint aroma of burning wood from their fireplace. I remember thinking how much the 'snaps' from the fire sounded like the 'round strip of red caps' we'd smash with rocks on the curb during the summer, only just a few months ago. Looking back, the fireplace may have been burning, but it was definitely the love and memories we shared that made us feel warm that day.

Worth mentioning - that Thanksgiving was the first time I had 'giblet' gravy, unbeknownst to me! I thought it was 'mushroom' gravy. So, a special thanks to my sister for describing, in detail, what giblets were to me, while I was eating! And apologies to everyone at that table for having to witness this 10-year-old's inability to keep giblet gravy down.

You know, growing up in the Kaminski household, my brother used to get blamed for almost everything (and rightly so) but this one ... this one was definitely on Lynda. Literally!
