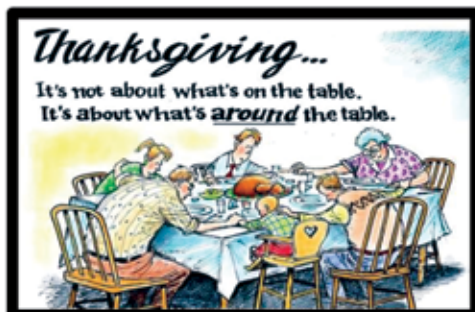

## Just a Note

Back in 1958, Mrs. Sabella was my first grade teacher, (*I can't remember what I watched on tv last night, but I can remember my first grade teacher's name.*) and she seldom gave out homework assignments – one of the things I loved about her. That said, one day she announced to our class, for homework, we were to have a conversation with our parents about what they did for a living. ‘Well,’ I thought, ‘*this assignment is going to be a cinch! I love to talk and ... there's no math problems involved!*’

That evening at the supper table, while passing bowls of vegetables around, I started my assignment - “*Dad, for homework, I have to tell the class what you do all day.*” Happy someone actually took an interest in his job, Dad went into great detail explaining his work with chemicals and inventing formulas for the company's products. I asked him, “*But what's your job called?*” He answered, “*I'm a Formulator.*” ‘Well, *that WAS a cinch,*’ I thought, and satisfied that I had completed my homework, I spent the rest of the evening watching television in the parlor.

The next day at school, it was time to present our assignments. Each child took their turn getting up to tell the class what their parents did for a living. I listened intently to my classmates talk about their parent's jobs - there were policemen, accountants, salesmen, and managers. Some of their mother's worked, too - as secretaries, bookkeepers, and bank tellers. I thought, ‘*All their parents have these really important jobs, and Mom's just a mom and Dad's a Formulator. Whatever that is ... I really wasn't paying attention.*’

It was my turn to get up and speak in front of my class and thought for a second about how boring my parents' jobs were: “*Oh, why couldn't my parents be more interesting?*” Then it happened. Standing in front of the class, the words just started flowing from my mouth: “*My mother is a Dancer called Bubbles, and my father works as her Manager.*” WAIT! WHAT?? Where the hell did that come from? Oh, that got the attention of the entire class, including Mrs. Sabella - who leaned forward and asked me where Mom danced. I broke into a cold sweat, and I didn't want to dig that hole any deeper, so I replied, “*It's a secret and I'm not allowed to say anything else!*” and I rushed back to my seat. Oh My Gosh!

At home, after school, Mom greeted me with, “*How was your day?*” A brief “*Fine!*” was my reply, as I had already made up my mind that I was taking the Bubbles story to my grave. Unfortunately, fate had something else in mind – Mrs. Sabella telephoned! Now I didn't know if my teacher called because she wanted to tell Mom about the vivid imagination her little six-year-old had, OR if she simply wanted to corroborate the colorful story of my mother's lurid occupation. Either way, this didn't bode well for me.

That evening, soon after Dad got home from work, I could hear both my parents in the kitchen ... laughing hysterically. ‘*Oh, that can't be good,*’ I thought, ‘*they never laugh during the week.*’

By 5:30, Mom had everything out on the supper table and shortly after she sat down with us, Dad turned to her and said, “*Uh, Bubbles, can you pass the mashed potatoes?*” WHAT? Did he just call her Bubbles? Oh my gosh - they know! ## Silver Ridge Park North Shed Rules

After discussion regarding sheds at the Silver Ridge Park North (SRPN) Trustee meeting, held on Tuesday, April 7, 2015, the Trustees unanimously agreed to Rules 1-8. Updated Permit/Form information - February 2019.

1. In keeping with Berkeley Township's Shed Ordinance, homeowners are permitted, effective this date, to install one (1) shed on their property; up to and including 120 square feet (10 ft. x 12 ft.);
2. Said shed may be of any structure material the homeowner desires;
3. Sheds that are required to be fastened must be on a firm ground structure. DO NOT place any shed on a cement slab. Cement slabs add square feet to your taxable living space and will be taxable by Berkeley Township;
4. Sheds may NOT be installed on any Common Ground Property;
5. In accordance with Berkeley Township Ordinance, sheds must be placed at least three (3) feet from the back property line and at least (3) feet from the side property line;
6. If a homeowner chooses to install a shed adjacent to their home, it may NOT block any windows or doors;
7. Homeowners MUST submit an Architectural Approval Request form to the SRPN Architectural Committee. *Architectural Approval Request forms are available in the SRPN Clubhouse Lobby;*
8. The homeowner MUST submit a **Zoning Permit Application**, required fees, and forms to the Berkeley Township Town Hall/Zoning Office. *Zoning Permit Application forms can be obtained from the Berkeley Township Website or Zoning Office.*

# IMPORTANT INFORMATION

## S R P NORTH HOMEOWNERS

### ARCHITECTURAL COMMITTEE

Prior to obtaining a permit from the Berkeley Township Construction Office and/or Zoning Office, homeowners must obtain a "Architectural Approval Request" form from the *Architectural Committee*. Sheds, upgrades, renovations, repairs, additions, exterior changes, anything pertain to the grounds, trees, driveway construction and sidewalks all require approval from the Architectural Committee. **Note:** Homeowners may need to submit a Zoning Permit Application, required fees, and forms to the Berkeley Township Town Hall/Zoning Office. Contact the Zoning Office for instructions.

### COMMON GROUNDS

No debris, grass cuttings, landscape material, leaves, old plants, tree branches should be dumped in the common grounds. **Violators are subject to Berkeley Township fines.**

### LAWS GOVERNING S R P NORTH

Mandatory Federal, NJ State, Berkeley Township Laws, SRPN Association Covenant-Restrictions and By-Laws and Robert Rules are instruments of the rule of law that the sitting Board of Trustees must follow to meet their obligations.

- Title VIII of the Civil Rights Act of 1968 (Federal Fair Housing Act)
- The Housing for Older Persons Act (HOPA)
- NJ State Public Law #L90-284 and PUB 100L430 Guidelines for the operation of senior communities.
- Berkeley Township Ordinance #118-1625. The establishment of a planned residential community for older adults. • Silver Ridge Park North's Covenants and Restrictions/By-Laws.
- State of New Jersey Full Disclosure Act and Regulations Title #5.

### SELLING/RENTING OF HOMES

When selling your home, either on your own or through a Real Estate Agent, you must notify the HOA **BEFORE** your buyer completes the 'New Purchaser's Packet' and provide the HOA with two (2) forms of identification; one being a photo ID showing birthdates for each occupant of the home. (See pg.2 for appt. information)  
**SRPN By-Laws require one (1) year homeowner's ownership prior to renting their property.**

Landlords AND Tenants must complete the HOA's 'Lease Agreement Packet' and provide the HOA with two (2) forms of identification; one being a photo I.D. showing birthdates for **each occupant and a copy of the Lease.**

All buyers and tenants (all residents) **must appear in person** at the HOA office with the required identification and paperwork. **Berkeley Township will not issue a C.O. (Certificate of Occupancy) without the HOA's Letter stating the buyer/tenants are in good standing with the Homeowners Association.**

### SIDEWALKS

It is each homeowner's responsibility to repair and maintain sidewalks on their property. All lifted and cracked sidewalks require repair at the homeowner's expense.

### TREES

It is the homeowner's responsibility to prune and maintain trees located on their property. Also, **no tree in the common ground, or wildlife corridor, may be pruned, removed, or topped for any purpose, including installation of solar panels.** Trees in these areas needing attention should be brought to the attention of the *Common Ground Trees Committee*.

### OTHER IMPORTANT REMINDERS

- Parking/storage of inoperable, unregistered, or uninsured motor vehicles, boats, or any other watercrafts, trailers, and/or recreational vehicles are not allowed anywhere on your property or Common Grounds.
- **Berkeley Township Ordinance:** Trash/garbage is to be put out at the curb **AFTER 4:00pm** on the day before a scheduled pickup. **RECYCLED ITEMS** are to be placed curbside, in reusable containers or paper bags, **AFTER 5:00pm** on the day before a scheduled pickup.
- All pets are required to be leashed. You must pick up and remove your pet's waste, even if you walk them in the common ground area.
- It is the Homeowner's responsibility to maintain their grass and/or stone lawns.
- **A Berkeley Township Ordinance strictly prohibits the feeding of wild animals** consisting of, but not limiting to, the following: DEER, rabbits, squirrels, chipmunks, and groundhogs. Wild birds are excluded.

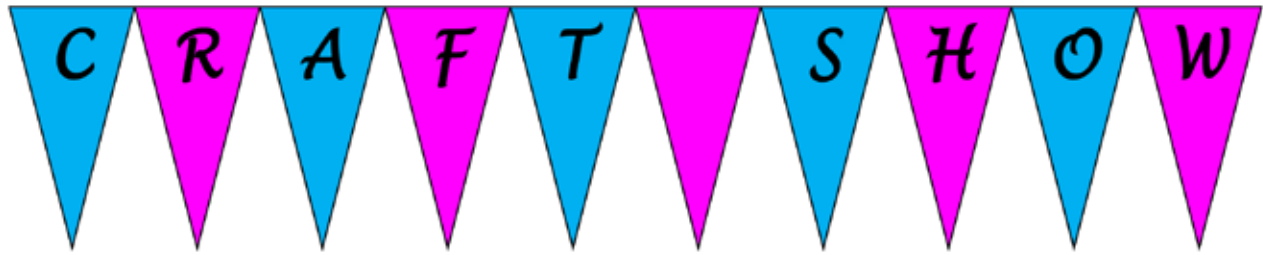

## **Still Paying It Forward**

### **YOU MAY NOT BE GETTING WHAT YOU ARE PAYING FOR**

Buy One Get One (BOGO) is not always a good deal. Most BOGO offers are for products that are nearing the end of their shelf life or usefulness. It is merely a means for the purveyor to recoup some or all of their purchase price. You can find this offer on almost any product from vitamin supplements to canned soda.

A way to ensure you are not wasting your money is to always check the expiration or "use by date". These dates do not mean that the product isn't any good. They merely are indicative of the product's reduced quality or effectiveness. Make sure you can use all of the product within a reasonable window so as to not waste your money.

Another example of pricing with BOGO is the original price of the merchandise is used as the base price. So, if a twelve pack of a soft drink normally sells for \$11.99 but has been on sale for the last two weeks for \$6.99 each, the price for two would have been \$13.98. The actual savings is only \$2.00. The advertisement leads you to believe that you are saving \$11.99. NOT SO!

An even worse scenario is "Buy one get one 1/2 off". If you were to apply the above example, you would not have saved any money. The price for two is \$17.98. If bought the week before, the price for two was \$13.98.

The reason these sales tactics are effective is because most shoppers do their grocery shopping at one location, thus they do not know or compare prices.

Lastly, the requirement to purchase multiples of a particular product to get a sale price may not be a savings for you either. When you apply pricing practices with shelf life and the time frame restriction to use the product at its peak effectiveness, you may be wasting your money.

Let's not forget storage. The longer you take to use your purchase, storage becomes a major concern. Improper storage or storing beyond the use by date only decreases the product's effectiveness. This applies to ALL bulk purchases, not just food items. JUST SAYING!

## **Still Paying It Forward**

### **BUYER BEWARE ~ LETS GO CAR SHOPPING!**

Purchasing an automobile can be a daunting and stressful experience. After all, it is the highest expenditure next to a home. While not illegal, sales tactics will confuse even the savviest buyers. Here are just a few to be aware of:

- \* A dealer offers 3.9% financing for 36 months. On a \$30,000 vehicle, your payment would be \$872 a month. Most buyers cannot afford such a payment. Consequently, most vehicles are financed for 60 months at 10%. At that rate, your payment would be about \$550 a month. All the advertisement does is get you into the sales room.
- \* A dealer offers you a cash back incentive. The key here is CASH BACK. The total contract price includes the cash back figure which is being returned to you. You are paying interest on the CASH BACK.
- \* Most dealers add additional charges to the window sticker by installing items that are popular such as wheel locks, pin striping, etc. Those are usually negotiable as they are very inexpensive for them to add.
- \* A more recent tactic is dealer added commodities such as home link, Spare Tire (very few new cars come with one), Navigation system, etc. The reason it is referred to as a tactic is because manufacturers are actually making cars that can be modified by dealers. The real catch here is a labor charge is added to the price for each dealer installed item.
- \* After negotiations, the salesman offers to reduce the sticker price of the vehicle to offset what you wanted for your trade. This has tax implications because the price applied to your trade reduces the tax on your purchase.

It is important to realize that not all dealers use these tactics. This article merely makes you aware of them and you can make an informed decision when making your next car purchase. There are many other gimmicks as well.

If the offer sounds too good to be true, it usually is.

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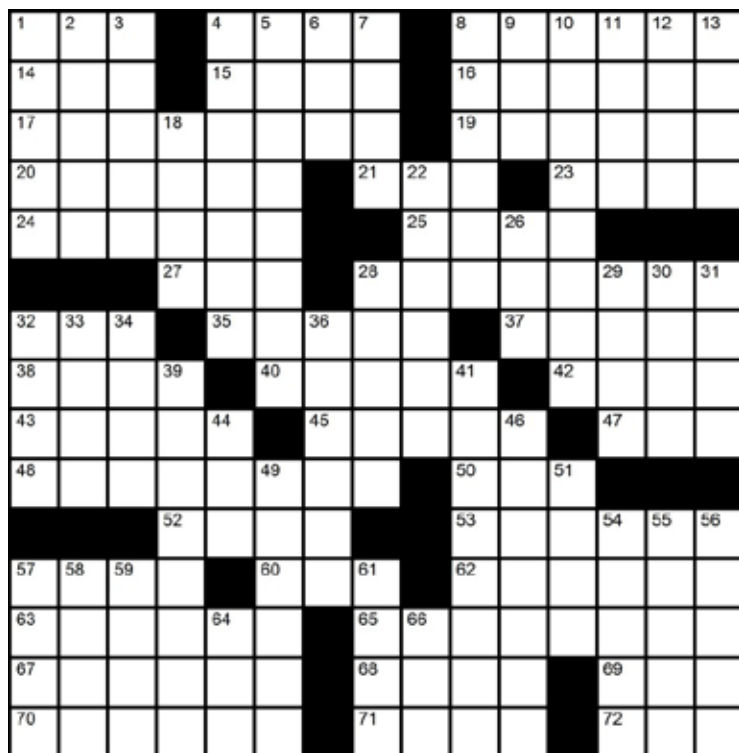

## Just a Note

### October Is Breast Cancer Awareness Month

Admittedly, and probably like most of you, I never paid much attention to the Public Awareness advertisement for **“One in Eight Women will develop breast cancer”**. (*I’m sure you’ve seen it. It’s the one that has 7 white, and 1 pink paper doll cut outs.*) Why would I pay attention? I had no family history of breast cancer, and I always went faithfully for my Annual Mammogram. But in 2019, that was the year I became painfully aware of every single magazine advertisement, television commercial, and billboard out there for Breast Cancer Awareness.

It was March when I received the telephone call (one month after my Annual Mammogram) telling me that it was ‘me’ who was the **One in Eight**. I immediately thought, *“Nah, someone must have made a stupid mistake!”* After all, I was in my late 60’s, I didn’t have any symptoms, no lump, no family history, and I felt great! But after the doctor showed me the films, indicating where the cancer was located, I saw for myself, there was no *stupid mistake* ... indeed, I had breast cancer.

Due to early detection, the cancer was still in early stages, so I had time to decide my options. I was told I could ‘wait and see’ if the cancer becomes more invasive and then act on it, or I could deal with it now. I’ve never been a ‘wait and see’ person, so I proceeded to set up consultation appointments with two different breast cancer surgeons the very next day. The two doctors each had a plan of action that were at opposite ends of the spectrum, leaving me frustrated, scared, and very confused.

Then a recommendation from a friend led me to a third consultation. That doctor explained in detail the type of breast cancer I had developed, recommended a procedure that would be the best outcome for me, and put my mind at ease by answering ALL my concerns. After three totally different consultations, I was blessed with finally finding the right cancer surgeon for me ... and came through my surgery and recovery with flying colors.

I continue to thank ALL those women who shared *their* personal cancer experience with me ~ because of them, my journey was a lot less scary, and less lonely.

*I’m hoping my story helps someone’s journey become less scary and less lonely, too.*

- Researchers say the incidence of breast cancer increases with age, and almost half of all new breast cancers in the U.S. are diagnosed in women aged 65 or over.
- Start with a Monthly Self-Breast Exam, “Feel It on the First” and inform your doctor of any concerns you may have.
- Men, not just women, can develop breast cancer - report body changes to your doctor.
- DON’T PUT IT OFF - go for your Annual Mammogram. Make your appointment. Remember that Early Detection Saves Lives!
- If something IS detected, and it’s not an emergency situation, ALWAYS get a second (or third!) opinion.

## Silver Ridge Park North HOA Inc

### Fence Rules

An Architectural Request for fence or fence panels along with pictures of proposed fencing must be submitted to the HOA before any work can begin. An approved Architectural Request must be submitted to Berkeley Township before a Zoning Permit is issued.

A copy of the Zoning Permit must be given to the SRPN-HOA for filing in homeowners file.

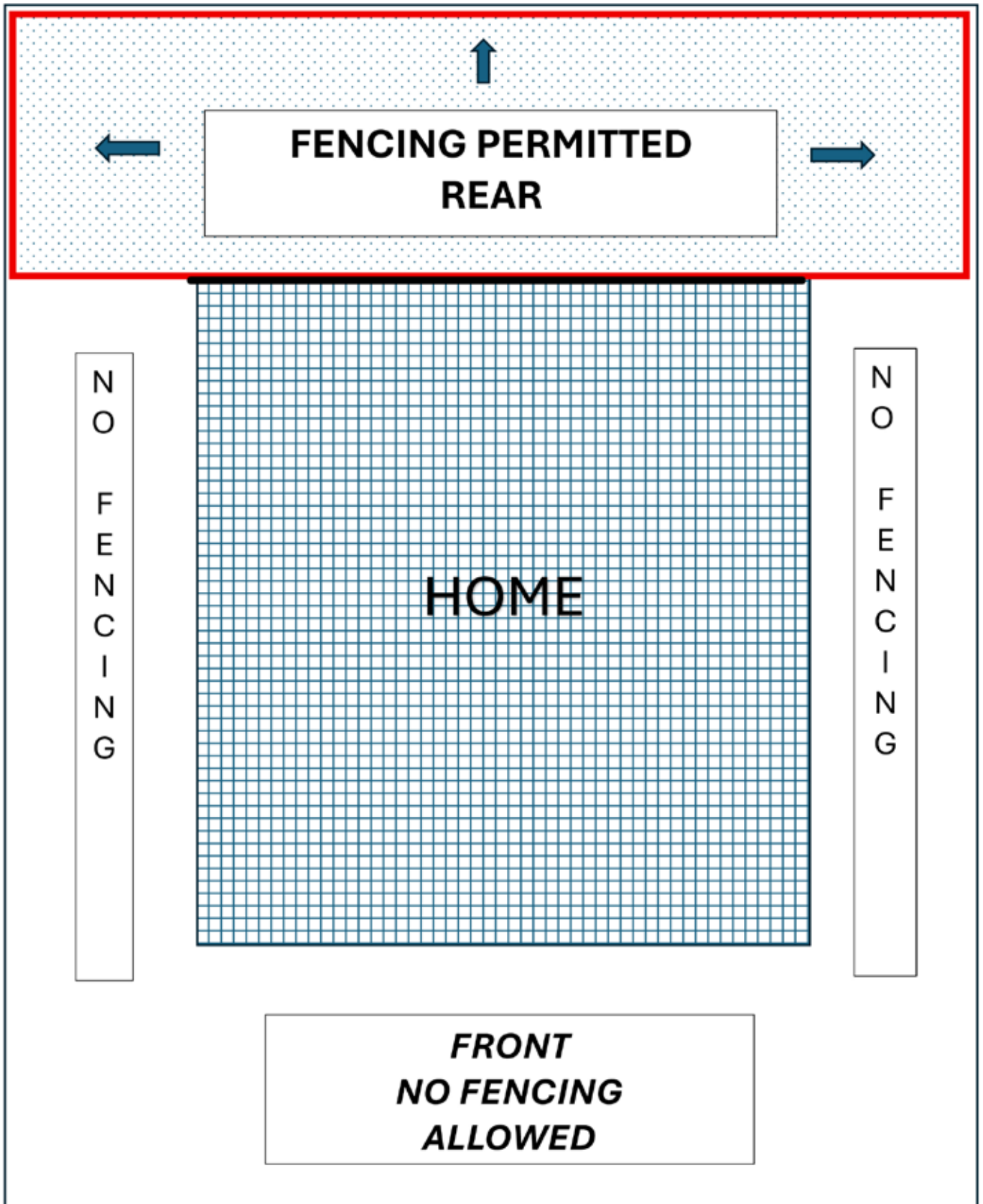
- Fences are **not permitted** on sides of Home from the Original Foundation to the Property Line.
- Fences are **not permitted** in front of Properties.
- Fencing will start at the rear of the original foundation and may extend to the rear Property Line. Within this area, fencing will be permitted to be installed the entire width from Property Line to Property Line. All fencing must be limited to the rear of the original foundation.
- Fences will be installed from grade. (No berms)
- Fence height is limited to 4 feet.
- White vinyl picket fencing, straight top or scalloped will be allowed.
- Aluminum "Pool Style" fencing will be allowed, black or white.
- Privacy panels will be allowed with the following restrictions: panels will be white or black vinyl. Panels will be no larger than 6' tall by 8' wide. Panels may be either solid or lattice style.
- There is a limit of two panels per property. One can be placed on either end of the rear of the house, not to go past the edge of the house, starting at the rear corner of the house going towards rear of property.
- Two panels may be placed on the same side of the property with an 8' space between panels. One panel must start at the rear corner of the house not going past the side of house.
- Black "decorative" fencing, no higher than 4', will be allowed around plant beds in front of homes.

In the event you already have fencing that has been approved by the Architectural Committee, you may keep that fencing. If you wish to change your fencing, you must follow these guidelines.

## **OCEAN RIDE ~ Reserve-A-Ride Program** Ocean County Transportation Services Department



Ocean Ride is a service for seniors (age 60 and over) and/or persons with disabilities (age 18 and over) on an advanced reservation basis *primarily* to destinations within Ocean County.

- Pre-registration is NOT required. Simply call to make your reservation when you have your appointment's date, time, and location. Trip cost/fare, and more information, can be found on the website listed at the bottom of this article.
- **Call Ocean Ride ~ Reserve-A-Ride Monday through Friday ONLY - 8:15 AM to 4:15 PM to make your trip reservation.**
- We accept trip reservations on a "first-come - first serve" basis, up to four (4) weeks in advance.
- **All trip reservation requests are handled by telephone only; Call (732) 736-8989 - then press "1" to speak with a Trip Reservationist.**
- The Reserve-A-Ride Program is primarily designed to serve routine medical needs of Ocean County residents. Unlike the Fixed Bus Routes, this service does not operate on the basis of a printed schedule, rather routes and pick-up times are developed each day in response to the service requests we receive.
- **All vehicles are wheelchair lift equipped.**
- Once your reservation has been made, the driver will arrive anytime within 1 hour to 1½ hours of the scheduled appointment time, depending on your travel distance.

In accordance with Ocean Ride's Safety Policy, **our Drivers are NOT permitted to enter your home, thus we require that you be at Ground Level for your scheduled pick up.**

**\*\* Riders will be billed via mail, the month AFTER service. \*\***
