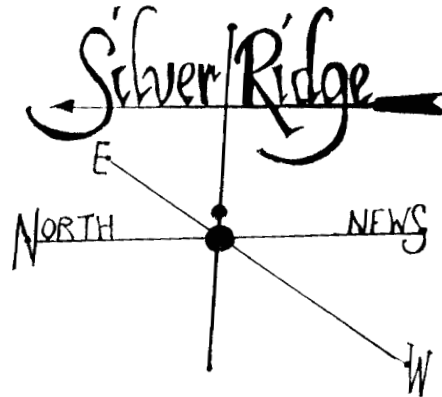

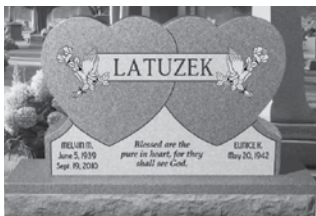

Just a Note

It was the first Tuesday in January 2018, and the Board of Trustees of Silver Ridge Park North was conducting its first HOA Meeting of the year. It was also the first time I was sworn in as a board member and given the responsibility to edit the community's newsletter, along with Joan Thompson. My husband Jack was the one who encouraged me, in August of 2017, to 'throw my hat in the ring' to be a Trustee – *"You're good with people and you like to help out. You should run. It'll give you something to do besides babysitting once a week. You might even make some new friends! It'll be good for you."* He was right. Editing the newsletter and being on the Board gave me a new purpose ... and new friends. Good friends. When Jack passed away the following June, *faith, friends and purpose* are what got me through that difficult time. And it's when I started writing short stories to fill up some blank pages in the monthly newsletter. Over the past eight years, the collection of stories have grown (maybe enough to self-publish a book! LOL) and so I thought you might enjoy reading my very first one (with a few tweaks), published in the September 2018 issue.

It was almost 8 pm when I tucked my 3-year-old great-nephew, Vance, into his bed. As I pulled down the window shade, I heard his little voice - *"Auntie, can you leave the shade up so I can see the sunset?"* *"Sure, but why?"* I asked. *"I like looking at all the colors change around."*

Knowing in a few weeks it would be dark by his bedtime, and this opportunity wouldn't come around again until next year, I sat on the edge of his bed and together we watched the colors of the sky "change around". As the sun slowly made its way down into the horizon, vibrant colors seem to explode across the sky. The puffy white clouds, ever changing their shapes, added to the night sky picture, with brush strokes of golden light beaming out from their edges. It was majestic and peaceful ... nature's art at its finest!

Time passed, and the bright colors melted into shades of muted blues and grays. The sky grew darker and set the scene with the perfect backdrop for that night's crescent moon and all the bright shiny diamonds in the sky. Sharing this beautiful summer sunset with a 3-year-old, made me remember what summer evenings were like when I was a child ...

We'd be out catching lightening-bugs in the front of our house, and playing *1-2-3 Red Light*, or *Hide-and-Seek* with the neighborhood kids - until the streetlights went on. Sometimes after dinner, Dad would load us into the car for a ride to *Applegate Farms*, for the best watermelon ice cream in the world! The three of us would run up to the window to purchased our frozen treats, while Dad opened up the back door of the station wagon. My sister, brother, and I would sit and our ice cream cones as our legs dangled over the rear bumper. We fought a battle of licking the streaks of ice cream running down the cone before it made its way to our forearms. Sometimes we won ... sometimes we didn't.

And then there were the nights that my mom and dad treated their three sunburned children (*who played in the backyard all day with the hose over the clothesline*) to a movie at the Route 3 Drive-In. For those of you who are not familiar with Bergen County, circa 1958, this Drive-In was smack in the middle of the Meadows. Known today as the Meadowlands, back then, it had fresh-water creeks with tons of cattails growing along the banks - and plenty of mosquito-filled marshland too! As a matter of fact, when you paid your admission at the Drive-In, you were handed a *Coil Pic* to burn on the dashboard of your car to keep the mosquitos away. (Truth be told, I swear it attracted them instead!)

And just like that night with Vance, at the end of those childhood summer days, there was often a beautiful sunset. There still is! You just have to remember to leave the shade up to see it. ☺

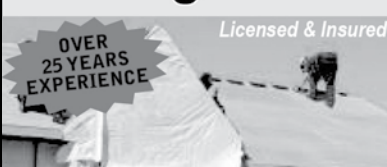
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IMPORTANT INFORMATION

S R P NORTH HOMEOWNERS

ARCHITECTURAL COMMITTEE

Prior to obtaining a permit from the Berkeley Township Construction Office and/or Zoning Office, homeowners must obtain a "Architectural Approval Request" form from the *Architectural Committee*. Sheds, upgrades, renovations, repairs, additions, exterior changes, anything pertain to the grounds, trees, driveway construction and sidewalks all require approval from the Architectural Committee. **Note:** Homeowners may need to submit a Zoning Permit Application, required fees, and forms to the Berkeley Township Town Hall/Zoning Office. Contact the Zoning Office for instructions.

COMMON GROUNDS

No debris, grass cuttings, landscape material, leaves, old plants, tree branches should be dumped in the common grounds. **Violators are subject to Berkeley Township fines.**

LAWS GOVERNING S R P NORTH

Mandatory Federal, NJ State, Berkeley Township Laws, SRPN Association Covenant-Restrictions and By-Laws and Robert Rules are instruments of the rule of law that the sitting Board of Trustees must follow to meet their obligations.

- Title VIII of the Civil Rights Act of 1968 (Federal Fair Housing Act)
- The Housing for Older Persons Act (HOPA)
- NJ State Public Law #L90-284 and PUB 100L430 Guidelines for the operation of senior communities.
- Berkeley Township Ordinance #118-1625. The establishment of a planned residential community for older adults. • Silver Ridge Park North's Covenants and Restrictions/By-Laws.
- State of New Jersey Full Disclosure Act and Regulations Title #5.

SELLING/RENTING OF HOMES

When selling your home, either on your own or through a Real Estate Agent, you must notify the HOA **BEFORE** your buyer completes the 'New Purchaser's Packet' and provide the HOA with two (2) forms of identification; one being a photo ID showing birthdates for each occupant of the home. (See pg.2 for appt. information) **SRPN By-Laws require one (1) year homeowner's ownership prior to renting their property.**

Landlords AND Tenants must complete the HOA's 'Lease Agreement Packet' and provide the HOA with two (2) forms of identification; one being a photo I.D. showing birthdates for **each occupant and a copy of the Lease.**

All buyers and tenants (all residents) **must appear in person** at the HOA office with the required identification and paperwork. **Berkeley Township will not issue a C.O. (Certificate of Occupancy) without the HOA's Letter stating the buyer/tenants are in good standing with the Homeowners Association.**

SIDEWALKS

It is each homeowner's responsibility to repair and maintain sidewalks on their property. All lifted and cracked sidewalks require repair at the homeowner's expense.

TREES

It is the homeowner's responsibility to prune and maintain trees located on their property. Also, **no tree in the common ground, or wildlife corridor, may be pruned, removed, or topped for any purpose, including installation of solar panels.** Trees in these areas needing attention should be brought to the attention of the *Common Ground Trees Committee*.

OTHER IMPORTANT REMINDERS

- Parking/storage of inoperable, unregistered, or uninsured motor vehicles, boats, or any other watercrafts, trailers, and/or recreational vehicles are not allowed anywhere on your property or Common Grounds.
- **Berkeley Township Ordinance:** Robo Trash Cans are to be placed in the street/curbside **AFTER 4:00pm** on the day before a scheduled pickup. Robo Recycle Cans are to be placed in the street/curbside **AFTER 5:00pm** on the day before a scheduled pick up.
- **ALL pets are required to be leashed. You must pick up and remove your pet's waste, even if you walk them in the common ground area.**
- It is the Homeowner's responsibility to maintain their own grass and/or stone lawns.
- **A Berkeley Township Ordinance strictly prohibits the feeding of wild animals** consisting of, but not limiting to, the following: DEER, rabbits, squirrels, chipmunks, and groundhogs. Wild birds are excluded.

Silver Ridge Park North Shed Rules

After discussion regarding sheds at the Silver Ridge Park North (SRPN) Trustee meeting, held on Tuesday, April 7, 2015, the Trustees unanimously agreed to Rules 1-8. Updated Permit/Form information - February 2019.

1. In keeping with Berkeley Township's Shed Ordinance, homeowners are permitted, effective this date, to install one (1) shed on their property; up to and including 120 square feet (10 ft. x 12 ft.);
2. Said shed may be of any structure material the homeowner desires;
3. Sheds that are required to be fastened must be on a firm ground structure. DO NOT place any shed on a cement slab. Cement slabs add square feet to your taxable living space and will be taxable by Berkeley Township;
4. Sheds may NOT be installed on any Common Ground Property;
5. In accordance with Berkeley Township Ordinance, sheds must be placed at least three (3) feet from the back property line and at least (3) feet from the side property line;
6. If a homeowner chooses to install a shed adjacent to their home, it may NOT block any windows or doors;
7. Homeowners MUST submit an Architectural Approval Request form to the SRPN Architectural Committee. *Architectural Approval Request forms are available in the SRPN Clubhouse Lobby;*
8. The homeowner MUST submit a **Zoning Permit Application**, required fees, and forms to the Berkeley Township Town Hall/Zoning Office. *Zoning Permit Application forms can be obtained from the Berkeley Township Website or Zoning Office.*

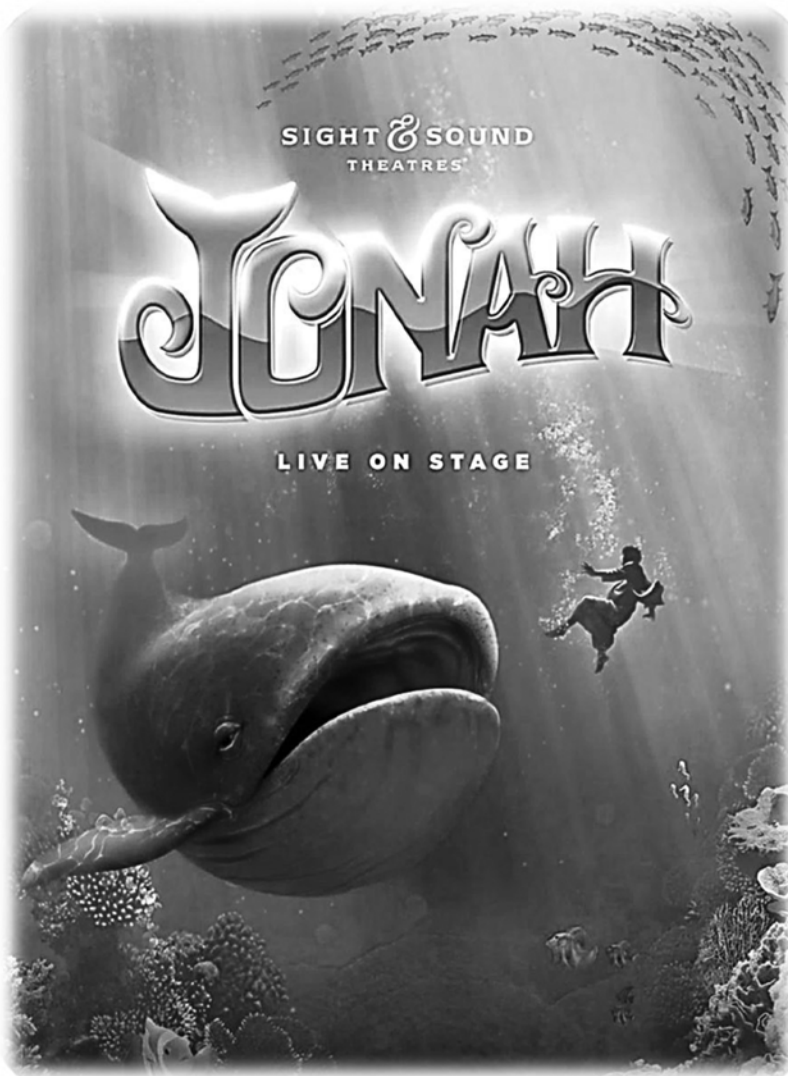

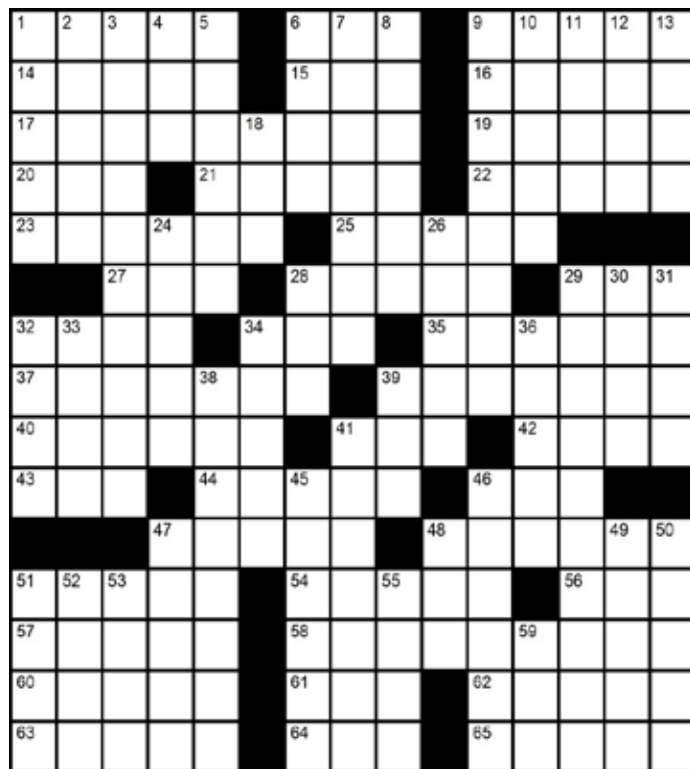

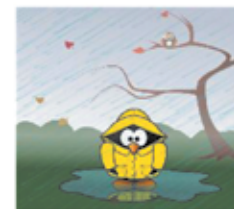

Sudoku

Sudoku requires no calculation or arithmetic skills. It is essentially a game of placing numbers in squares, using very simple rules of logic and deduction.

The objective of the game is to fill all the blank squares in a game with the correct numbers. There are three very simple constraints to follow. In a 9 by 9 square Sudoku game:

- Every row of 9 numbers must include all digits 1 through 9 in any order
- Every column of 9 numbers must include all digits 1 through 9 in any order
- Every 3 by 3 subsection of the 9 by 9 square must include all digits 1 through 9

Every Sudoku game begins with a number of squares already filled in, and the difficulty of each game is largely a function of how many squares are filled in. The more squares that are known, the easier it is to figure out which numbers go in the open squares. As you fill in squares correctly, options for the remaining squares are narrowed and it becomes easier to fill them in.

OCEAN RIDE ~ Reserve-A-Ride Program

Ocean County Transportation Services Department

Ocean Ride is a service for seniors (age 60 and over) and/or persons with disabilities (age 18 and over) on an advanced reservation basis *primarily* to destinations within Ocean County.

- Pre-registration is NOT required. Simply call to make your reservation when you have your appointment's date, time, and location. Trip cost/fare, and more information, can be found on the website listed at the bottom of this article.
- **Call Ocean Ride ~ Reserve-A-Ride Monday through Friday ONLY - 8:15 AM to 4:15 PM to make your trip reservation.**
- We accept trip reservations on a "first-come - first serve" basis, up to four (4) weeks in advance.
- **All trip reservation requests are handled by telephone only;**
Call (732) 736-8989 - then press "1" to speak with a Trip Reservationist.
- The Reserve-A-Ride Program is primarily designed to serve routine medical needs of Ocean County residents. Unlike the Fixed Bus Routes, this service does not operate on the basis of a printed schedule, rather routes and pick-up times are developed each day in response to the service requests we receive.
- **All vehicles are wheelchair lift equipped.**
- Reserve-A-Ride Round Trips: \$6.00 (Riders with Attendants, each pay \$6.00 per Round Trip)
- Once your reservation has been made, the driver will arrive anytime within 1 hour to 1½ hours of the scheduled appointment time, depending on your travel distance.

In accordance with Ocean Ride's Safety Policy, **our Drivers are NOT permitted to enter your home, thus we require that you be at Ground Level for your scheduled pick up.**

STILL PAYING IT FORWARD MEDICAL BILLS

The rising cost of living expenses is no stranger to medical bills. While it is necessary to seek medical advice for ailments, the manner in which the physician recommends treatment is very important.

Let me preface this article by saying that **nearly 70% of physicians own or have a controlling interest in various treatment facilities including surgical facilities not associated with local hospitals.** While that is not necessarily a bad thing it does warrant a patient's attention.

Here are some questions that need to be addressed when the physician recommends a course of treatment. That being said, treatment at these facilities are usually cheaper. **Just make sure your Insurance provider covers the cost.**

- 1) Question a recommendation for a protocol scan of any type. *What does it accomplish and can I forego the scan?* These may include an MRI, CT and echocardiograms.
- 2) Routine lab work can also be a problem. **There are certain categories of bloodwork that Medicare does not pay for and in some cases neither will your Medicare supplement.** As a precaution, ask the phlebotomist ahead of time if any tests ordered will not be paid for by Medicare. Most of them are well versed in Medicare, and you can refuse that particular test. While most physicians also know what is not covered; many scripts are written by nurse practitioners who are less versed in Medicare coverage.
- 3) When test are ordered, **always question the need, possible side effects or complications, cost and consequences,** if you opt to forego that avenue of treatment.
- 4) If treatment, tests or other methods of treatment are recommended, ask for them in writing and **have the Medical Code included for each procedure.** If you call Medicare and provide them with those codes, they will tell you if it is covered. These are also called Billing Codes.
